This is just a summary of our monthly application, some additional information for this time of year and special offers. You will receive your invoice and inspection report in your email or by mail after your service has been done.

We are at that time of year with longer days & shorter nights and lack of rainfall. It is important you are watering and at least putting down 1" per zone. **See reverse for information on watering with the current restrictions in place.** When watering you should be watering long enough to get 1" of water into the root system, approximately 45-60 minutes per zone, depending on your system. If water overflows it maybe less. You should start watering no earlier than 5:00 am. If you notice brown areas that are different than the dormant areas you can put out an empty tuna can or cat food can to measure that area to see how much water you are actually getting in that area. If your not getting 1" you may need to add a water hose there to make up the difference. **Only rain provides 100% of coverage not irrigation systems.**

This treatment includes contact insecticide, both slow and quick release nitrogen, and potassium, to help promote growth and reduce past winter injury as well as past fungus injury (take-all patch & Pythium Blight). **As always please remember you need to water your application in to get the full benefits of the materials.** We will continue to treat for any active fungus at time of service. If we have to return for a blanket application there is an extra charge for the fungicide treatment. Even when we treat for fungus it can appear even days to weeks after treatment depending on weather conditions. Several properties are still recovering from cold/frost injury to both the lawn & trees/shrubs. This will take time to recover just because we have a few days of warmer weather does not mean it will green up overnight. **Please do not scalp your lawn at this time, it is not the right time and could cause more damage. Also do not apply any additional products to your lawn.** The applications are designed to strengthen the root system and improve growth when it starts to get warmer and help with recovery. **You have to be patient at this time.**

It is important you are mowing at the correct heights for your type of turf, for St. Augustine lawns, the blades should never be lower than 3.5 -4 inches of total length left after mowing, Bermuda lawns 1.5" to 2.5" , and Zoysia 2—3 inches. Do not mow if frost is on the turf. If you have any exposed runners/roots, please apply top soil to cover and protect them from the elements. This will aid in the recovery process. If you have larger areas you will need to put in plugs, seed, or sod depending on how large they are, no Bahia.

WATERING INSTRUCTIONS BASED ON RESTRICTIONS AS OF APRIL 1, 2026

Even with the phase II watering restrictions, you can water after applying fertilizer in Florida.

Water management districts such as SJRWMD and local ordinances allow for watering in chemicals, including fertilizer, within 24 hours of application.

Use enough water to move the nutrients to the root zone without causing runoff or leaching. Hand-held hose or micro spray system is allowed anytime.

Timing: Water within 24 hours of applying fertilizer if possible. Especially during hotter times to avoid burning your lawn. If the fertilizer application was immediately preceded by heavy rain, additional watering may not be necessary depending on how much rain you received. At least 1-2”.

It is always recommended that you water your lawn long enough to get the water into the root system where it needs to be. For most irrigation systems that is 45-60 minutes per zone. Long enough to get about 1” of water each time. Longer watering promotes a deeper root system and a healthier lawn. Watering for shorter time frames and not getting the water into the roots keeps the roots closer to the surface. This will require more frequent watering and is quicker to dry out, which can result in damage during droughts.

INFORMATION FROM FERTILIZER SUPPLIERS:

The weather is heating up and if you’ve been watching conditions lately, you already know we’re dealing with more than just “normal” spring stress.

We are currently experiencing extreme to exceptional drought conditions, with a rainfall deficit estimated between 15–25 inches and some of the driest conditions on record.

We’ve also been under a water shortage declaration, driven by prolonged below-average rainfall and declining groundwater levels.

What that means for turf:

- Soil profiles are not recharging
- Hydrophobic conditions are increasing
- Root systems are under stress from both drought and heat
- Irrigation alone is becoming less effective
