This is a summary of our monthly application, along with additional information for this time of year and special offers. You will receive your invoice and inspection report in your email or by mail after your service has been done.

Depending on the amount of rainfall you are getting, you may have to continue to water at least 45-60 minutes per zone. It is imperative that the lawn is receiving at least 1" of water per week and more in areas of full sun. Not all irrigation systems are the same so time may differ. If you notice brown areas you can put out an empty tuna can or cat food can to measure that area to see how much water you are actually getting in that area. If turf is crunchy, or leaf blades are folding like a pencil, this is evident of a dry area/hot spot. You may need to add a water hose there to make up the difference. Only rain provides 100% of coverage not irrigation systems.

This treatment includes a slow release nitrogen, potassium, and micronutrient package. Insecticide for all turf damaging insects with a residual to help with the control of turf damaging insects. Unfortunately there is no insecticide that prevents flying insects from getting into the lawn. **As always please remember you need to water your application in to get the full benefits of the materials.**

Due to cooler nights the grass is just now starting to wake up and grow so several properties are still recovering from cold/frost injury to both the lawn & trees/shrubs. To help with recovery please make sure you are mowing weekly, and watering properly to help the grass to grow and grow out the injured areas. Top soil can be added in bare areas, areas with exposed runners/roots. If you have larger areas you may need to put in some plugs, seed, or sod depending on the size of the area. NO BAHIA. It is also important you are mowing at the proper height for your turf grass. St. Augustine 3.5-4 inches, Zosia 2-3 inches, Bermuda 1.5 to 2.5 inches. Do not scalp your lawn at this time. This is taking time to recover once you are mowing more often and removing that old damage the lawns will look much better. It will not get green overnight. **Do not apply any additional products to your lawn. The applications are designed to strengthen the root system and improve growth when it starts to get warmer and help with recovery. You still have to be patient at this time.**

WATERING INSTRUCTIONS BASED ON RESTRICTIONS AS OF APRIL 1, 2026

Even with the phase II watering restrictions, you can water after applying fertilizer in Florida.

Water management districts such as SJRWMD and local ordinances allow for watering in chemicals, including fertilizer, within 24 hours of application.

Use enough water to move the nutrients to the root zone without causing runoff or leaching. Hand-held hose or micro spray system is allowed anytime.

Timing: Water within 24 hours of applying fertilizer if possible. Especially during hotter times to avoid burning your lawn. If the fertilizer application was immediately preceded by heavy rain, additional watering may not be necessary depending on how much rain you received. At least 1-2”.

It is always recommended that you water your lawn long enough to get the water into the root system where it needs to be. For most irrigation systems that is 45-60 minutes per zone. Long enough to get about 1” of water each time. Longer watering promotes a deeper root system and a healthier lawn. Watering for shorter time frames and not getting the water into the roots keeps the roots closer to the surface. This will require more frequent watering and is quicker to dry out, which can result in damage during droughts.

INFORMATION FROM FERTILIZER SUPPLIERS:

The weather is heating up and if you’ve been watching conditions lately, you already know we’re dealing with more than just “normal” spring stress.

We are currently experiencing extreme to exceptional drought conditions, with a rainfall deficit estimated between 15–25 inches and some of the driest conditions on record.

We’ve also been under a water shortage declaration, driven by prolonged below-average rainfall and declining groundwater levels.

What that means for turf:

- Soil profiles are not recharging
- Hydrophobic conditions are increasing
- Root systems are under stress from both drought and heat
- Irrigation alone is becoming less effective
